**TRIO UPDATE.** Thank you to everyone who has considered the information set out in the TRIO (The Responsibility is Ours) letters distributed across Beckminster in September and for your responses to those letters.

From the responses to those letters, there will be an increase in regular giving to the church, including the effects of gift aid and similar benefits, of around £700 each month. We have also received single donations which, with gift aid, are nearly £750.

The Leadership Team and Church Council have also been looking at whether we can reduce our costs or raise money in other ways. We are still exploring and making progress on both of these.

As a result of your responses, the church's finances are now looking much healthier than 6 months ago. Our expenditure this year is still likely to be higher than our regular income, but the shortfall will be very much less than last year and will be manageable through our use of legacy funds.
