This year at Christmas the focus is on giving new toys to asylum seeking children living in hotels and in the community. ABCD. Action around Bethlehem Children with Disability works to improve the lives of children with disabilities across Palestine, regardless of faith, race or gender. It has 37 years of experience, and is guided by principles of humanity, neutrality, independence and impartiality. It supports local health centres to deliver high-quality, child-centred care. I came across this organisation several years ago when we received an ABCD Christmas card from the Shuttleworths. I made a few enquiries and discovered that it is a relatively small charity working in 4 UN Refugee Camp Rehabilitation Centres. Having renovated and equipped these centres, ABCD supports the professional development of the therapists. Alongside basic holistic rehabilitation, the teams give educational and psychological support, speech and language therapy, and provide technical advice and home adaptations.

It all started when a British paediatric physiotherapist, Val Jourdan, volunteered at the Bethlehem Arab Society for Rehabilitation (BASR). Following her stint there, and with the help of friends, the charity was set up. Now over 80, she is still the beating heart of this wonderful charity. I am delighted that we have become friends.

Sadly, in recent weeks the Nour Shams Refugee Camp has suffered some infrastructure damage from IDF action and settler violence, but an appeal has already been made to help fund repairs.

I hope you will feel able to support ABCD by attending Beckminster's Coffee Morning on Saturday, 16 December. John Ashwood.
